## **Initialize PoolScout Camera and App**

- Using the pool owner's phone or other mobile device, install the PoolScout app from the App Store® or Google Play®.
- Note that this step does not have to be conducted by the final mounting point of the camera but is recommended so as to ensure your Wi-Fi connection is strong and stable.
- Step 1 Follow the app instructions to setup the user account. If you are an installer, please select Installer Mode.
- Step 2 Connect the antenna to the camera unit and power up the PoolScout Wi-Fi camera with the power cable. You should hear a loud initialization tone after 10-30 seconds.
- Step 3 Open up the PoolScout App and follow the instructions to setup your
  account (if you haven't already done so in Step 1). If you are an installer, please
  select Installer Mode. Follow the camera pairing steps


Once the initialization is complete, proceed to mounting the camera per the instructions inside the App and in the next chapter Camera Mounting.



## **Camera Mounting**

Before installation, give thought to a suitable mounting location and how you will route wiring back to the power socket and home network router if you want to use the Ethernet network cable instead of Wi-Fi. The camera is typically mounted on an outside wall with power to the Camera.

The ideal mounting height for the PoolScout Wi-Fi Camera is 8-10 feet off of the ground. The final mounting location should allow for a clear view of the entire pool and surrounding area at all times. Do not allow anything such as sunshades, basketball hoops or other poolside objects to block the camera's view, even temporarily.



The ideal mounting location:

- should provide an unobstructed view of the pool and at least 6 feet of the surrounding area
- should be 8-10 feet off the ground
- shouldn't interfere with its surroundings or be vulnerable to damage
- · Allow for power cable routing





## **Camera Mounting**

### Installation Tips

- Ensure the camera mounting position is well in range of your home router as PoolScout requires a strong and stable internet connection at all times
- Do not face the camera towards any light sources.
- Do not point the camera towards a glass window as it may result in poor image performance due to window glare by infrared LEDs, ambient lights or status lights.
- Do not place the camera in a shaded area and point it towards a well-lit area. Or, it
  may result in poor image performance. For better image quality, please make sure
  that the lighting condition for both the camera and the capture area is the same.
- For better image quality, it's recommended to clean the lens with a soft cloth from time to time.
- Make sure the power ports are not exposed to water or moisture or blocked by dirt or other elements.
- Do not install the camera at places where rain and snow may hit the lens directly.
- The camera may work in extreme cold conditions as low as -25°C.



# Wi-Fi Alarm Mounting

- Ensure the alarm unit position is well in range of your home router as PoolScout requires a strong and stable internet connection at all times
- Pair the alarm unit using the PoolScout App and follow the instructions inside the App
- Make sure the power ports are not exposed to water or moisture or blocked by dirt or other elements.

## **Initialize Pool Settings and Alarm Unit**

### Step 1

Ensure that the PoolScout Camera is initialized as shown on page 3 and that all components are connected as shown in the mounting diagram page 4-5.

 It may take a few minutes for the camera to connect and apply any available updates.

### Step 2

Follow the instructions **in the PoolScout App** to set up the pool, allowing the system to detect the pool boundaries and enable the Activity Zone.

 To avoid unnecessary alarms from unwanted areas, it is crucial to properly set up the Activity Zone.

### Step 3

Follow the instructions in the PoolScout App to setup the Alarm Unit. A slow blue flashing light indicates the Alarm Unit is ready for pairing.

- Make sure the Alarm unit is plugged in within Wi-Fi range.
- Make sure the Alarm's light is slowly flashing blue. If not, press and hold both of the Alarm's volume buttons for 5 secs. If flashing quickly retry until a slow blue flashing light
- Find and connect to Alarm
- Enable and pair Alarm
- To complete the account setup, the app will guide you through the steps for the Pool Setup and adding People to your PoolScout account.
- Enjoy your pool with the added level of comfort and security that your PoolScout Home system provides!
- Reminder: The PoolScout System, including any sensors, cameras, software, and alarms are NOT a substitute for personal, adult supervision of pool activities and pool patrons.



# **Troubleshooting**

### No Power to the Camera or Alarm Unit

If you find your camera is not powering on, try the following solutions:

- Please check whether the outlet is working properly or not. Try to plug the camera into a different outlet and see if it works.
- Please check whether the DC adapter is working or not. If you have another 12V DC power adapter which is working, please use another power adapter and see if it works.
